Febr. 16 Dadaastanae in Bithynia; eligitur imperator Nicaeae Valentinianus Febr. 26; Nicomediam ingressus est Mart. 1; Constantinopoli die Mart. 28 fratrem Valentem sibi adscivit imperii consortem (Ammianus 26, 4, 3); inde procedunt Naissum (l. c. 26, 5, 1), hinc Sirmium (l. c. 26, 5, 4); denique Valentinianus Mediolanum venit, Constantinopolim Valens (26, 5, 4) ibidemque hiemantes consulatum a. 365 inierunt (l. c. 26, 5, 6). — Subscriptiones ut numero multae sunt, ita difficile explicantur. Inscriptiones duae Febr. 19 et Sept. 27 Iovianum nuncupant, reliquae incipientes a Ian. 11 Valentinianum et Valentem; utrumque genus quamquam veris temporibus contrarium inde explicandum erit, quod compilatores annis singulis inscriptiones singulas praeposuerunt easque saepe perversas.
